We know that children and adults need music to be human. That is why we have developed a mobile music program available to schools and home daycares. Our course includes singing to develop language skills, movement to develop motor skills and rhythm to develop spatial skills that help with math and science. Studies from the American Music Conference have shown that children who regularly participate in music have shown dramatic improvements in memory retention skills, eye hand coordination, and spatial temporal reasoning skills. Adolescents who continue to study music show higher SAT scores than those who don't.

We also offer an educational Early Childhood Music Program right in your school or daycare. A developmentally appropriate music program to which each child will be introduced to a multitude of instruments, creative movement, singing with a group, soloing, listening, singing of literature and rhythm.

Children and teachers will be introduced to different songs including folk, multicultural, educational and traditional, religious (religious if your have a religious school) songs. Each child will learn their natural singing voices and keep the perfect pitch they were born with. Exercises are introduced to develop listening skills. Percussion instruments will be brought in for each child and rhythm will be taught through playing these instruments. Pre-reading of music will also be introduced to age appropriate children, usually 3-6 to enhance their music ability later when they choose to join our piano program or another instrument of choice in grade school. Creative movement is done each week to encourage coordination, laterality, spatial awareness, directionality and body awareness. Musical instruments such as trumpets and violins are brought in to be introduced and do "Hands On" experiences. Each group will learn more socialization and have a wonderful time while learning all aspects of music.

Music in Motion offers 6 programs for your school:



Program #1

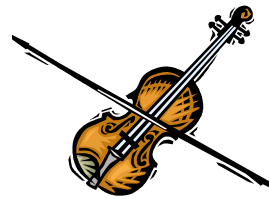
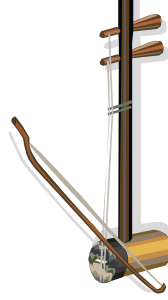
An hourly program that is subsidized out of your schools music budget, so that all children may participate in a quality music program. We usually recommend 2 classes of 1/2 each of no more that 15 children in each class. The program is available for children ages 2 to 6. You choose the day and time, then choose either a weekly or bi-monthly program.



Program #2

This is an enrichment or after school program. Parents pay for an extra curriculum class for 8 or 10 week sessions. We come to your school on the day and time you designate. We have a 8-child minimum for these 45 minute classes. All marketing and invoicing for the program for your school is done by our company. Your school benefits by our program, because we donate 10% back to your school in the way of musical instruments or music classes for your school. With tight budgets in Early Childhood programs, who cannot use more materials or extra classes to enhance your program?





Program #3

A one time class, where our teachers come in and introduce children up to 25 students to multicultural instruments from around the world. Learn what a Didgeridoo from Australia is, a violin from Vienna or talking drums from Africa and Bodrum Drum from Ireland. What a great program when you do your multicultural program at your school or just for fun.

We explain where the instrument comes from around the world and then allow students to go around and actually have hand's on experience with them.



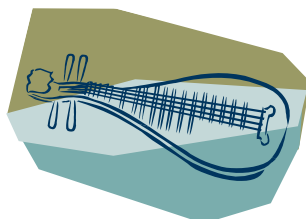
Program #4

Piano Classes for your students ages 4 and up. Beginning Piano Classes that are offered to 8 children at one time. We bring in 8 keyboards (1 for each student) and teach them basic note recognition, finger placement, keyboard scales and ear training. Introduction to basic songs, singing and music games. Piano classes are 6 levels, starting with level 1 and are 10 weeks for each session.



Program #5

Recorder classes for children ages 5-8. Children will be introduced to basic note reading and playing of a basic soprano recorder. Classes may have up to 15 students per class. Classes are also 10 weeks and have 4 different levels. Starting with Level 1 and progressing up each session. This course teaches finger dexterity and placement, site note recognition, and musical note reading and scale memorization. Playing of simple songs along with music games.



Program #6

Dulcimer classes for ages 5 to 9. A dulcimer is a 3 string instrument that is played on the lap from the Appalachian Mountains. Children will assemble this instrument, including artwork, and stringing and then learn to play basic songs. Children learn finger dexterity, note

Session is 8 weeks and requires a minimum of 8 students and no more than 15 per class.
